It takes approximately 400 milk bags to make an adult sized mat.

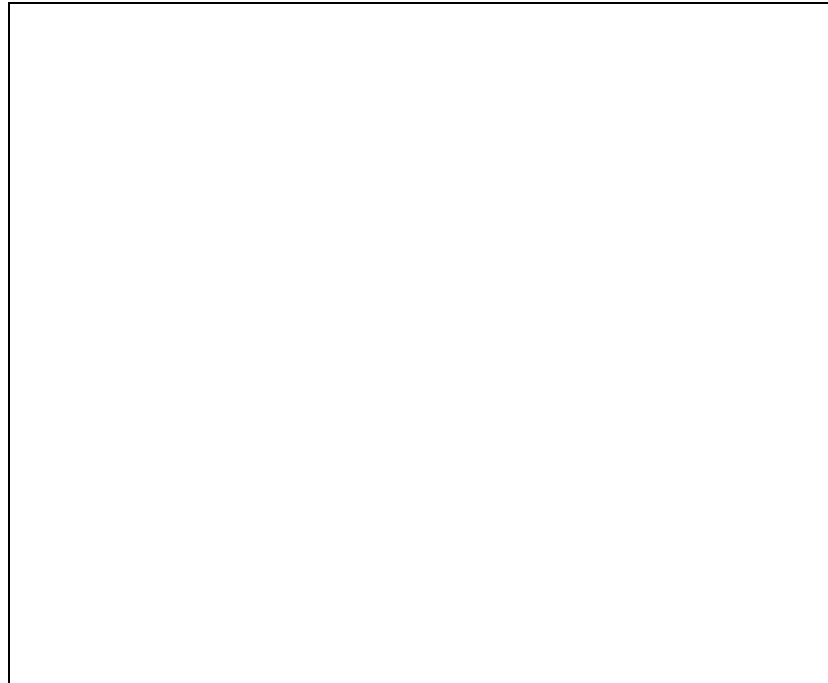
