We are blessed that you are here to worship God this morning and we welcome you to the family. Please join in a time of fellowship and refreshments in Celebration Hall following the worship service.



This morning is the 3rd Sunday in the Celebration of Lent. This year we are asking everyone to pick up a Mardi Gratitude calendar and keep track of things you are thankful for this month. They are located in the front foyer.

In reaction to the Coronavirus and endeavoring to keep everyone healthy Session has decided to cancel our Sunday morning coffee in Celebration Hall following our service for 2 weeks. We will continue to watch the situation and keep everyone updated.

The PCC is reminding all congregations to pray for all those being infected by the Coronavirus and to follow the guidelines of Public Health Officials to prevent infection and avoid virus exposure. General prevention measures include:

- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 15 seconds. If soap and water are not available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer.
- Avoid touching your face with unwashed hands.
- Avoid close contact with people who are ill.
- Stay home virus symptoms (e.g., fever, cough, trouble breathing).
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces

Let us be mindful of the people in our community, keep contact with those who are vulnerable, offering to shop etc. for those unable to get necessities.

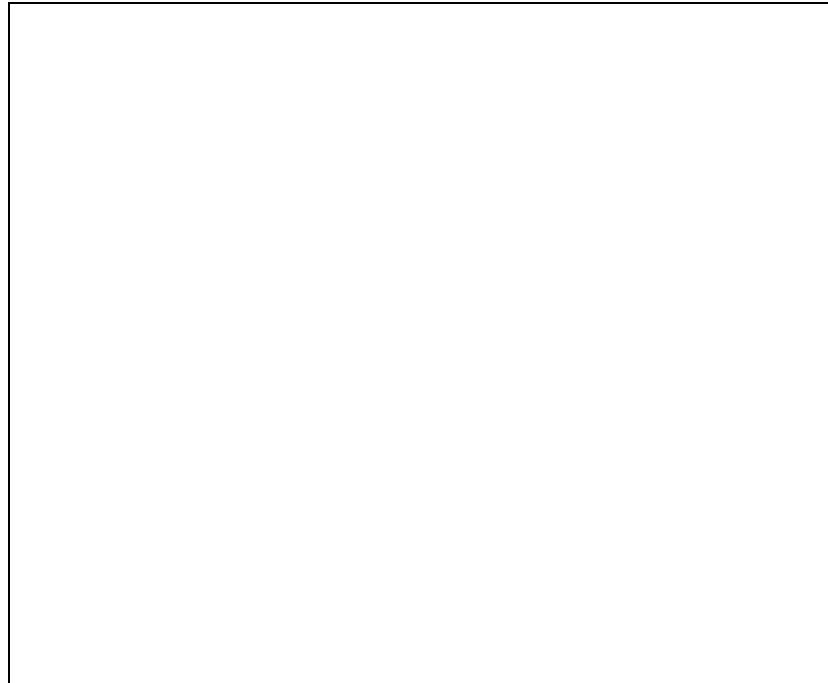
