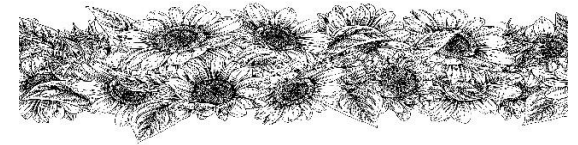

Crew.

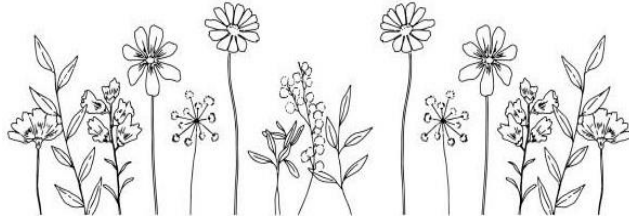
Joke Corner

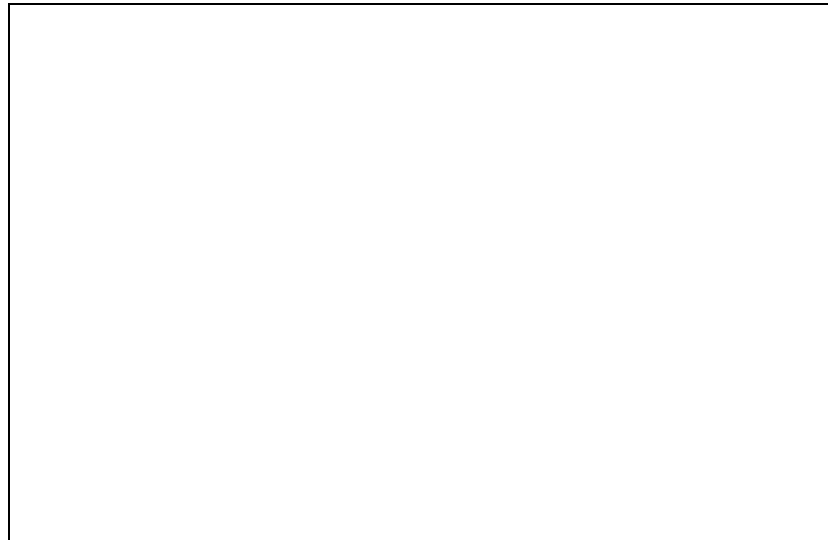
