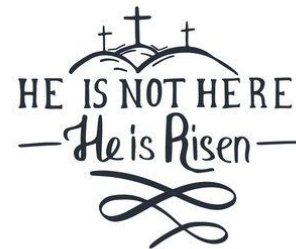

Duty Elders are always looking for extra hands in the kitchen, if you have some time consider lending a hand during coffee after our service on Sunday mornings.

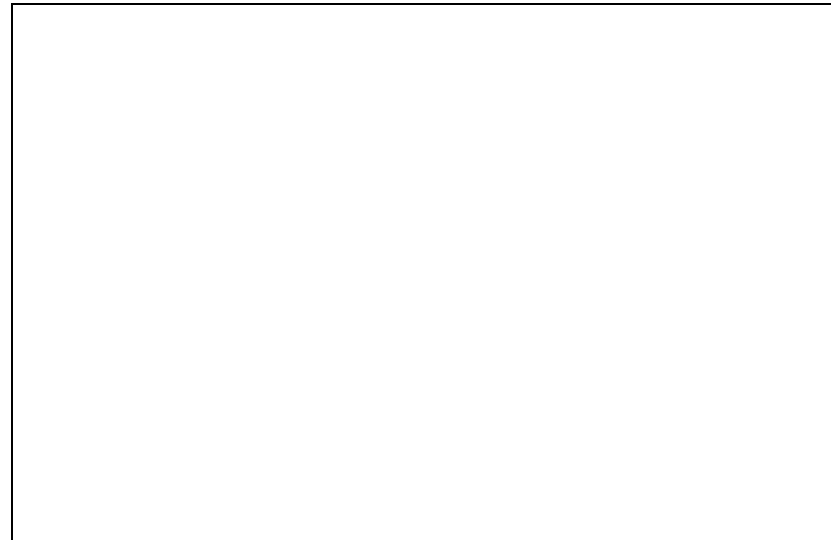
