Search Committee: The Committee met this past week and are looking at finalizing the details of the church profile.

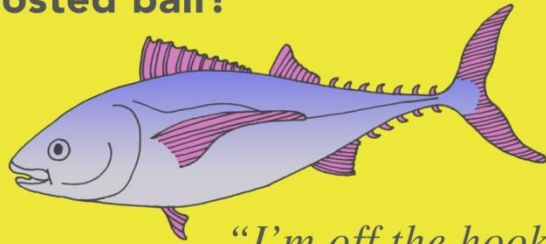
Living Faith Golf Tournament: As there was no interest in this event we will not be running the golf tournament this year.
